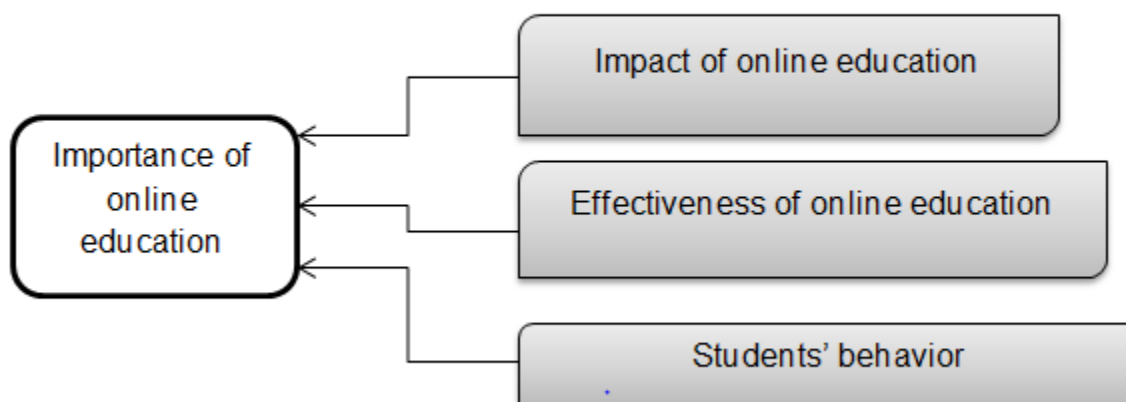


Figure 1: Proposed theoretical framework
